# Social Media Policy



Playing and competing for the Belleville Bulldogs R.F.C. is a privilege, not a right. As an athlete, you are held to a certain standard of behaviour, and are often seen as role models to our younger fans. As leaders, you have a responsibility to represent your team, community, and yourself in a positive manner at all times – including on social media sites.

Remember, everything you post online is public information. Any photo, text or video posted is out of your control the moment it is placed online. Google has a VERY long memory and has ways of digging up information from years past, even things you thought had been deleted. Third parties can easily access your online profile – examples include teachers, officials, and future employers. Inappropriate materials found by these third parties could seriously affect your image, your team, and the Belleville Bulldogs R.F.C.

## Examples of inappropriate behaviours:

- Posting photos/videos of yourself or teammates acting inappropriately in Bulldog attire.
- Unsportsmanlike content – criticizing coaches, teammates, opponents, officials, the Belleville Bulldogs R.F.C. or other rugby clubs.
- Use of slurs, degrading or foul language.
- Discussing team issues or club problems.

*Should there be an occurrence where inappropriate conduct is reported, depending on the severity of the incident; the athlete will meet with a member of the board and their head coach to discuss their penalty.*

## For your own safety, please keep the following recommendations in mind:

- Don't post anything you wouldn't want your parents or future employers to see/read.
- Set your security setting high so only your friends can view your profile.
- You should NEVER post your home address, local address, phone number, email or other personal information online.
- Be aware of who you are making connections with. If someone you don't know tries to "friend" you, be cautious to accept the invitation.

- Thank fans that supported your latest game.
- Congratulate other athletes and teams on their accomplishments.
- Think about whom you may affect before you post.
- When you are angry, upset or frustrated – sleep on it before you post about it!
